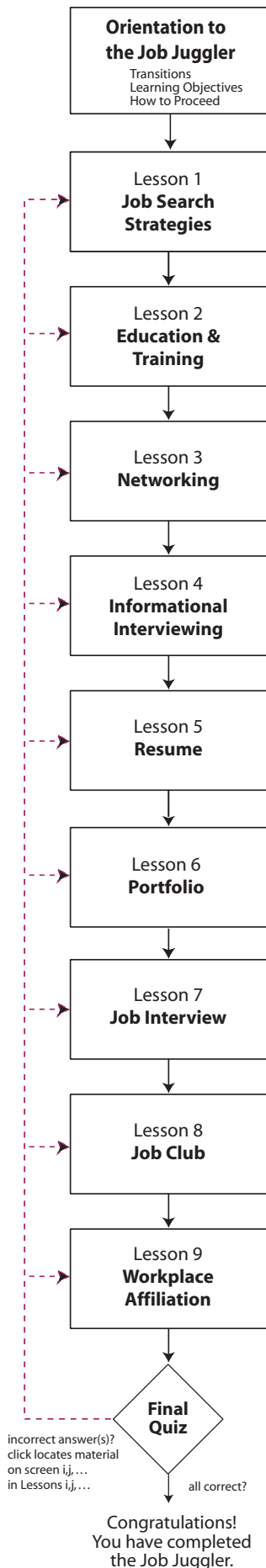
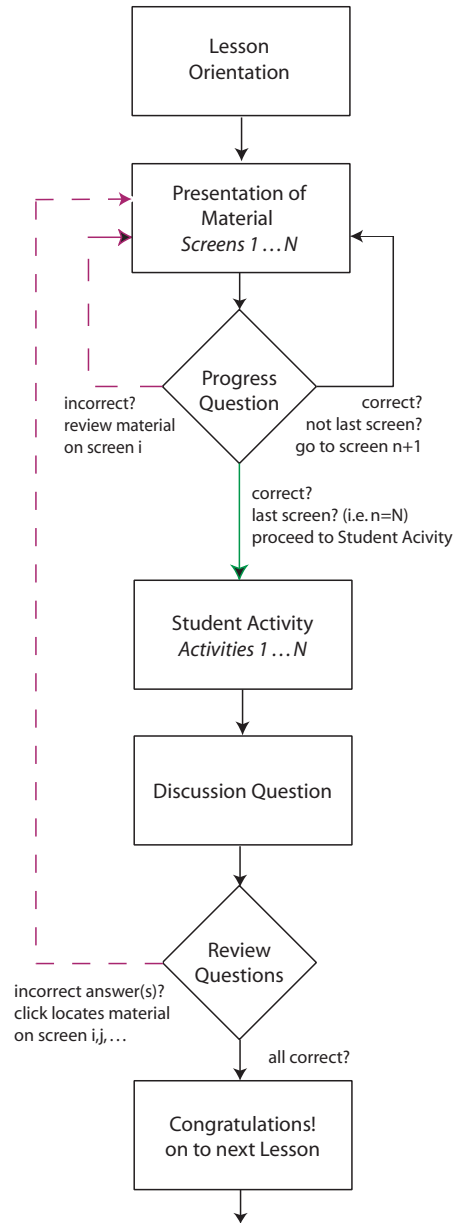




The Job Juggler

Progress Questions

Provide resistance to proceeding until student demonstrates required competence on a screen of material. This exercise also assists students to think about and remember material before proceeding. Students proceed in this loop until all screens of material are completed.

Student Activities

Student develops and practices skills, such as accessing resources, and organizing materials for efficient retrieval.

Discussion Questions

Provide opportunity for student to reflect on material, organize thoughts, and share these collaboratively with the Course Supervisor and other students.

Review Questions

Student tests mastery of lesson before proceeding to next. Wrong answers activate links to review relevant course material until correctly answered.
